You may be wanting to continue your theological education to equip you for your preaching ministry and wider work in the church. Through study and fellowship at Cliff College you will be intellectually stimulated, spiritually enriched and enthused for mission and ministry. The academic year is built around residential teaching blocks offered in September/October and in January/February, when students come to Cliff for a week of lectures, seminars, and Christian fellowship. It is, however, the dimension of fellowship that continually takes students by surprise. We seek to steep the academics in an atmosphere of worship and devotion, sharing of personal testimonies and the ways God has blessed the work of ministry in the many different contexts from which students come. Amidst the rigor of academic learning, the Holy Spirit always turns these residenceals into a means of grace: times in which students and tutors alike find healing, encouragement, and exhortation to go on to greater things in God.

If you are a recognized Anglican Reader, you are eligible to apply to study for a University of Manchester Postgraduate Certificate through Cliff College. You may never have thought of studying mission and theology at university level but Cliff College is opening up this possibility to all recognized Anglican Readers. You can choose from one of three programmes available.

The Postgraduate Certificate is made up of two units, each of which are delivered as an intensive teaching week of seven days followed by a period of guided reading and the submission of a 6-8,000 word assignment approximately 10 -12 weeks later. As a fully accredited local preacher you have already demonstrated the ability to study theological subjects. This can be advanced through a Postgraduate Certificate and successful completion of the Postgraduate Certificate also makes a student eligible for Diploma or MA studies. Cliff has an excellent track record in enabling students without formal educational qualifications to be successful at undergraduate and postgraduate study.

Students would normally complete the Certificate in one year, graduating with their University of Manchester Postgraduate Certificate at a ceremony normally held in June annually. It is also possible to spread the study over two years.

## PROGRAMME DETAILS

### Students will:

- Attend one designated residential teaching week at Cliff College each semester. Lectures, seminars and tutorials are used to introduce the main areas and themes relating to course units, enabling course members to engage in informed reflection.
- Be allocated a tutor who is available to offer help regarding any aspect of the course and monitor progress.
- Read key texts and other sources from an extensive reading/resource list.
- Produce an assignment (c6-8,000 words) for each unit from a list of topics based on course units.
